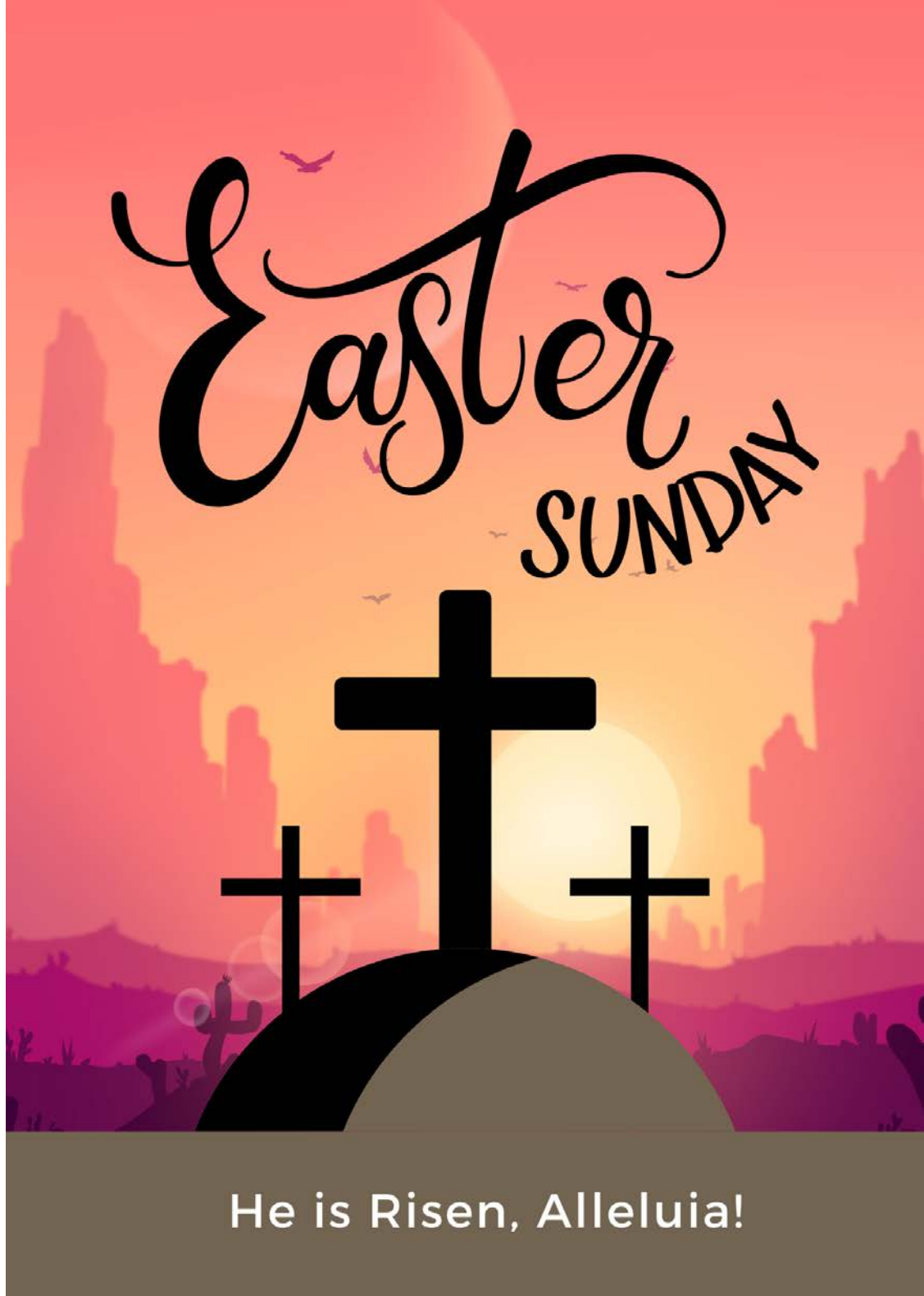




He is Risen! Alleluia!
